




New mounting holes for Canadian style boxes and all MC/AC cable boxes


- * Mounts 1-1/2" to 2-1/8" deep boxes.
- * Accommodates 4" to 4-11/16" boxes.
- * RBS16 has 3 mounting holes and RBS24 has 4 holes.
- * Plaster rings can be mounted separately eliminating the need for an electrical box for low voltage cabling.
- * Offset design eliminates drywall bulge.
- * V-notched on center to help ensure consistent positioning.
- * Use with wood or metal stud 16" to 24" on center.
